CPT 84460	Blood test to measure an enzyme that is found mostly in the liver may mean liver disease if level is high.	\$122
CPT 82247	Measure of the amount of bilirubin in the blood. Bilirubin is made when hemoglobin is broken down by the body. Hemoglobin carries oxygen in the blood.	\$377
CPT 82040	This test measures the amount of albumin in serum, plasma, or whole blood. Often used to decide nutritional status, renal disease, and other chronic diseases, mostly those involving the kidneys or liver.	\$84
CPT 84075	Blood test to measure the amount of alkaline phosphatase in the blood. ALP is an enzyme that shows liver cell damage or to check for cystic fibrosis in an unborn baby.	\$88
CPT 84155	Blood test to measure nutritional status or how well nourished someone is.	\$123
CPT 84450	Blood test to check the level of an enzyme that is found mainly in the heart and liver. Level is usually low unless there has been damage such as after a heart attack or liver disease.	\$122
