Collection	Collect stool specimen in clean airtight container without preservatives.	
Specimen Preparation	5 g stool in a clean airtight container without preservatives.

Sample Stability	Ambient, unacceptable; Refrigerated, 14 days; Frozen, 30 days	
Unacceptable	<ul><li>Specimens in media or preservatives</li><li>Specimens received beyond stability</li></ul>
