2024 MRI Classes are now on-line!

Did you know, UCHealth has their own on-line MRI school? These programs are certified by the Colorado Division of Private Occupational Schools and award college semester credits. These credits are recognized by the ARRT as approved academic courses as "category A" CEU's per semester credit. These credits are transferable to most college's and can count toward your bachelor's degree at most institutions (in healthcare).

2024 UCHealth School of Radiologic Technology – MRI Online Course

18 semester credits (88.5 CAT A CEU's)

The UCHealth School of Radiologic Technology – MRI program is a <u>9 month program</u> consisting of class and clinicals. Tuition costs are \$3,000 per semester for a total of \$6,000 and <u>qualifies for tuition reimbursement</u> within UCH.

First semester classes are scheduled for <u>January</u>, <u>22nd</u> <u>2024 - May 8th 2024</u>, <u>Monday and Wednesday from</u> <u>4:00-5:30 PM on-line</u>. Clinical rotations will start February 5th through June 8th. Colorado Springs students will have MRI lab on Tuesday evenings from 6:15 – 8:15 pm.

Second semester classes are tentatively scheduled for <u>June 10th 2024 – September 25th 2024 Monday and Wednesday from 4:00-5:30 PM on-line</u>. Clinical rotations will start June 10th through November 2nd 2024.

Clinical Requirements for MRI:

Students must have approval from the MRI department supervisor within their region to provide 12 to 16 clinical hours per week for a minimum of 256 clinical hours each semester. Colorado Springs and South Metro regions are already pre-approved for MRI clinical sites.

Students outside of the Colorado Springs or South Metro regions; approval from the desired clinical MRI cite must be granted before the start of the program. Please reach out to the Radiology school to help coordinate a clinical site within UCH.

Students will be allowed to coordinate their own clinical schedule based on the availability of each MRI scanner.

Students must complete a minimum of 125 exams with the ARRT.

Prerequisites: Current UCH employee and registered technologist with the ARRT in any of the following: Radiography, Nuclear Medicine Technology, Radiation Therapy, or Sonography.

Please submit applications any time before November 3, 2023. Interviews will be held the week of November 13, 2023.
