CPT 82247	Measure of the amount of bilirubin in the blood. Bilirubin is made when hemoglobin is broken down by the body. Hemoglobin carries oxygen in the blood.	\$125

CPT 84075	Blood test to measure the amount of alkaline phosphatase in the blood. ALP is an enzyme that shows liver cell damage or to check for cystic fibrosis in an unborn baby.	\$111

CPT 84450	Blood test to check the level of an enzyme that is found mainly in the heart and liver. Level is usually low unless there has been damage such as after a heart attack or liver disease.	\$154
