Myeloid (DNA) NGS Testing

Routing and Report Location Update

Effective 09/08/2025, some Myeloid NGS testing for specific sources will transition from being performed at Children's Hospital of Colorado Precision Diagnostics Laboratory (CHCO PDx) to Colorado Molecular Correlates Laboratory (CMOCO). The location of the .pdf result reports in Epic will vary depending upon the laboratory that performed the test.
