Course Fees 2026

Starting in June 2026 the Colorado SANE/SAFE Project will be implementing fees for select courses. Here is what you can expect regarding course fees.

When does this start?

The new fee applies to the following courses beginning on or after June 1.

Comprehensive Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner Program – beginning June 1, 2026, registrants will be charged a fee

- Colorado Residents: Full course fees are due at registration. Thanks to grant funding from the State of Colorado, in-state participants are eligible for a full refund upon successful completion of the course within the designated timeframe.
- Non-Colorado Residents: Full course fees are due at registration. While grant funding is limited to Colorado residents, we're happy to offer refunds for cancellations made at least 30 days prior to the course start date

Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner (SAFE) Clinical Skills Lab – beginning August 1, 2026, registrants will be charged a fee upon registration

- Refunds are only issued for cancellations within the required timeframe.

Who has to pay the fee?

All students are required to register individually through the event registration system and submit the registration fee at the time of registration.

Why is there now a fee?

As our program has grown, so have the costs to run it. This fee helps us continue offering strong course content, support, and resources.

This change is not a penalty for any action, nor is it being applied selectively. This change is being implemented across the board for all registrants of the listed courses. Fees may apply to additional courses in the program in the near future.

What forms of payment are accepted?

Because the fee is paid online through the event registration system, only credit and debit cards are accepted at this time.

Does this change how I register?

No. The links on our website will still take you directly to the event registration. However, because course fees are applied at the time of registration we will no longer be able to enroll students outside of session dates, and sessions will not be re-opened for late enrollments.

What happens if I don't finish the course on time?

Unfortunately, refunds are only available for qualifying students who complete the course or those who cancel their registration within the required timeframe.

Fee Refunds 2026

Starting in June 2026 the Colorado SANE/SAFE Project will be implementing fees for select courses. Here is what you can expect for refunds of course fees.

How do refunds work for in-state students?

If you are an in-state student and complete your Comprehensive course on time, you will receive a full refund. This refund is made possible through generous state grant funding.

How do I get a refund?

When cancelling, students should contact our program email at [saneseafeuhealth@uchealth.org](mailto:sanesafeuhealth@uchealth.org) to notify us of a need to cancel and a staff member can assist with initiating the refund. Otherwise, refunds will be processed in the manner described in the next section.

When will my refund be processed?

Refund timing for those who qualify depends on the type of course you take and/or the timing of your cancellation. Refunds will be processed as follows:

- For online courses, refunds will be processed on a quarterly basis.
- For in-person skills labs, refunds will be issued within 30 days of successful course completion.
- For cancellation 30 days or more prior to course start date, refunds will be processed as promptly as possible following verification of eligibility.

Students who do not complete their course, do not attend (no show), or cancel within 30 days of a course's start date **will not receive a refund**.

Where will my refund be sent?

All refunds will be issued back to the original payment method used during registration. Refunds will not be issued by mail.

How long will it take to get my refund?

Course fees should be fully refunded within 7-10 business days of processing.

If my refund doesn't go through, what should I do?

Please contact our program email at [saneseafeuhealth@uchealth.org](mailto:sanesafeuhealth@uchealth.org) to notify us. We will work with the support team to resolve the issue as soon as possible.

Can I get a refund to retake the course if I don't finish in time?

No. Each course has established completion requirements. The **Comprehensive Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner Course** must be completed within the allotted 12-week timeframe, and the **Clinical Skills Lab** requires full attendance on both scheduled days.

Students who do not meet these requirements are not eligible for a refund. Those wishing to retake a course must submit a new registration and pay the applicable course registration fee.
