

COVID-19 Convalescent Plasma Process

Thank you so much for your interest in donating what is known as COVID-19 Convalescent Plasma or “CCP”

* You must have an FDA approved/ validated positive PCR nasal swab or antibody test for COVID-19 within the past three months and be symptom free for at least 14 days in order to be considered as a potential donor. We will need a copy of these test results in order to move forward with the process listed below.

Our process for evaluating potential donors

The Donor Recruiter will contact you to schedule a pre-screening appointment to make sure that you are eligible to be a CCP blood donor – all CCP donors must meet the established donor requirements. This initial screening appointment will be via phone. During this appointment, we will:

- Review the blood donor requirements.
- Ensure we have a copy of your test results are FDA approved/ validated and make sure that it has been at least 14 days since your last symptoms or 14 days from your positive test if you had no symptoms of COVID-19.

You are not eligible to donate CCP if you received the COVID-19 vaccine or participated in the vaccine trials.

If you are a female donor and have had at least one pregnancy, we will schedule an appointment to take a tube of blood to do an HLA test – plasma from females who have been pregnant may present a risk to certain patients.

Once you have successfully completed the pre-screening, one of our UHealth Garth Englund Blood Center staff members will reach out to schedule you at our Fort Collins location (address located below).
