UCHealth COVID-19 Code Roles/Personnel

Response must be limited to ESSENTIAL personnel only, one person per role, others remain outside unless called. The HOSPITAL SUPERVISOR/CHARGE RN on the unit will notify you if a role has been filled and ask you to remain outside.

Exiting the room is a controlled, time intensive process and will be directed by CHARGE RN/HOSPITAL SUPERVISOR outside the room. Please carefully follow all instructions as provided. Only one person may exit the room at a time.

It is MANDATORY that ALL personnel entering room should be garbed in PPE at the *highest level available*: N95/half face respirator with face shield or PAPR/face shield, and contact precautions. IT IS MANDATORY THAT PPE BE DONNED PRIOR TO INITIATING CODE RESPONSE.
